

P3-950 Digital Video Recorder, (DVR)



The P3-950 DVR records images from wireless cameras which are sent to the MTV Receiver.

It allows triggered recording when used in conjunction with other Millennium Sensor equipment such as the P3-100 Microwave Sensor or P3-300 Tripwire via MRT's, cameras and a UBA

The DVR is factory set to record up to 200 minutes per Gigabyte but FPS and image quality can be changed by the user through the on screen menu.

Note: When increasing the amount of time per Gigabyte, image quality may be decreased.

Features

- Time / Date Stamp
- Motion Detection Capable
- Externally programmable through handheld IR remote and on screen menu
- IP-64 Rated when covers are closed
- Fully integrated with Millennium Sensor P3 equipment

Opening the DVR

- Hold the DVR in both hands. With the end facing you place your thumbs on the hinge. Lightly push up and swing the door open towards you to access the connector ports on one end and the SD card on the opposite end.
- **Do not attempt to 'pry' open covers**

Operations

Connects to MTV or Cameras via an interconnect cable

Must be used with MTV or MRT/UBA/Camera combo. It will record each time a sensor is triggered.

Can be configured for continuous recording when situations warrant

Requires an external battery source when not being used with MTV

IR Remote control with on screen programming

Activate DVR

- Connect as instructed in the "System Operations" tab or the DVR manual.
- When sensor(s) are activated, the DVR will record from the camera(s) that have been deployed.
